






BUILDING A BRIDGE USING THE FIVE PLANKS

- 5. "I need what only Jesus can give."










12 Steps That Show Christianity Is True

- 1. Truth about reality is knowable.
- 2. The opposite of true is false.
- 3. It is true that the theistic God exists.
- 4. If God exists then miracles are possible.
- 5. Miracles can be used to confirm a message from God.
- 6. The New Testament is historically reliable.
- 7. The New Testament says Jesus claimed to be God.
- 8. Jesus' claim to be God was miraculously confirmed by:

- a. His fulfillment of many prophecies about Himself;
- b. His sinless and miraculous life;
- c. His prediction and accomplishment of His resurrection
- 9. Therefore, Jesus is God.
- 10. Whatever Jesus (who is God) teaches is true.
- 11. Jesus taught that the Bible is the Word of God.
- 12. Therefore, it is true that the Bible is the Word of God (and anything opposed to it is false).

Example: Apologetic Lite Question Did you know that one of the greatest atheistic philosophers of the twentieth century gave up his atheism before he died? Do you know why he did this?

Antony Flew's Story



At a 2004 symposium he announced his new beliefs to the world, his change of heart was "almost entirely because of the DNA investigations".



(Now at this point if this person says:)

"I still don't think God exist," then ...GO DEEPER!

"It is easier to believe that infinite mind can make matter than it is that finite matter can produce a mind that can contemplate the infinite."




Establishing the Existence of God

Because if there ever was a time where there was nothing, there would still be nothing.

- 1. Would you agree that if something presently exists,
- 2. And something can not come from nothing,
- 3. Then something must have always existed.

Removing Their Barriers





Now if it is valid to argue from effect to cause, then there are other attributes about this Creator that he/she must possess other than being an infinitely power.


For example since we are a moral effect, we know our Creator must be moral also. Since you and I are intelligent, we know our Creator must be intelligent. As a result, we can conclude that this Creator must be infinitely intelligent, infinitely moral, and infinitely powerful in order to create the universe.

Building A Foundation For Belief In A Theistic God

Argument from the reality of <u>intelligent</u> <u>effects</u> - God is an intelligent cause

Argument from the reality of moral effects – God is a moral cause

Argument from <u>effect</u> to cause - God is an infinite power



This God is identical to the God described in the Bible, a Theistic God

Cosmologists have theorized that the universe is 94 billion light-years long.


Obviously that is only how big the known universe is. Certainly the power to create stars and galaxies in that big space, had to be pretty powerful. So our






If we see the world through a theistic lens we can build an unshakable foundation



- 1. Find Common Ground with those you are trying to reach.
- 2. Build a bridge from point of shared beliefs (even those they are not quite aware of Rom. 1:20; 2:14-15)

Possible transition questions:

- Would you agree that there is more evidence now for an intelligent designer than say 40 or 50 years ago?
- Do you think it's even possible that if the universe had a beginning, then we may have a Creator?

Possible transition questions:

- Do you think it's possible that if scientific evidence supports a beginning for the universe, then it may be possible that we are put here for some kind of purpose?
- If we do have a Creator, what would be most important to ask, if you had the opportunity?


Possible transition questions:

- Now if we do have an intelligent Creator who's good and moral... do you see how we might be accountable in some way?
- Do you agree that our Creator probably meant for us to experiencing life in a better way than what we are currently experiencing these days? (Rev. 21:4)

 Can I share with you what I believe about my faith that provides the kind of hope that some are looking for?






Our Goal: Help nonbelievers surface the truth that we are accountable to our Creator in some way.



















Our Goal:

Now many of us feel this sense of alienation because of this separation from our Creator, but some of us may try to bring about greater reconciliation by doing good things to make up for our short comings.


The problem is that no matter how much good we do...it is still not going to make a difference. Let me explain what I mean by this by giving an illustration.

Plefalk TWO: I cannot measure up

Suppose you have done something to hurt your spouse, significant other, or good friend deeply. How can you reconcile with them? Can you do something very nice and sacrificial for their parents that will bring about a restored relationship? Obviously not.


 So why would we think that by doing good things for others that somehow that will help us in our relationship with our Creator?

Now if you and I have a standard of what is right and wrong and we don't live up to it, can you imagine that God's standard might be higher than our own?



We know that people like Mother Teresa and Gandhi did some good things in their life.






But we also know others that did some really evil things

PLANK THREE: I am a sinner


The Bible teaches that our rebellion against God has caused a separation between God and us.

PLANK THREE: I am a sinner

 Now if our sins have to be judged, and we are not capable of changing our situation, what can we do?

Answer: We need to turn to an outside source.

(This then allows us to look for another way other than our own effort)





 Would you agree that a dirty thing cannot clean itself?

 Would you agree that the only person who can clean away our sins must be perfectly clean himself? Did you know that Jesus was the only person in history who claimed to forgive sins and at the same time lived a sinless life Himself?



Christ's Unique Life

Not only was Jesus unique in living a sinless life, he also gave evidence that he had power over death. Do you know how he did this?

Answer: By rising from the dead!

Christ's Unique Life


Do you know any other person in history who died, and came back to life and told us what was on the other side?


 Do you know why it is so important for Christians that Jesus actually rose from the dead? (Rom. 8:11) **Christ's Unique Life**


Answer:
