

















When we evangelize, we need to know where people are at.





SCRIPTURE COMMANDS US TO DEFEND THE FAITH

BEING READY

"Being ready is not just a matter of having the right information available, it is also an attitude of readiness and eagerness to share the truth of what we believe."

BEING READY

The Greek word for ready (Hetoimos) is used in Matt 24:44 and Luke 12:40 to communicate the idea that as Christians we need to anticipate Christ's return.



WHAT DOES IT MEAN TO "BE READY" IN 1 PET. 3:15?

If we combine 1 Peter 3:15 with 2 Corinthians 10:5 and I Cor. 9:22, it is clear that our responsibility is also to **eagerly** anticipate the questions and objections and remove barriers whether others ask us a specific question or not!



This is what the Apostle Paul did...



Being Ready means...

You and I should be so changed by Christ that we care so much about the lost around us that we will eagerly look for those opportunities to remove barriers and help them take steps to the cross, whether we are asked specific questions or not.


Observations:

- When you and I have this eager anticipation, we will have a greater impact on people.
- You and I will have this greater eagerness when you and I are a certain kind of disciple of Christ.
- A disciple who's rooted and rested and has an eager readiness to give an answer for the hope we have.


