


Norm Geisler discovered early in his spiritual journey...

- 1. ...that faith and reason are more compatible than some Christians realize.
- 2. ...that there is an appropriate way to use apologetics (Christian evidence) in our witness to others and yet in partnership with the Holy Spirit.
- 3. ...that we have more common ground in witnessing to nonbelievers than they realize.

Important Things To Know About Our Faith

- Biblical faith must have an object to be valid. 1.
- 2. Our faith is not a blind faith, It is a faith with reason.
- It is a faith that is supported by evidence. 3.
- Our subjective experience of Christ is only valid if it corresponds to an objective truth.
- The bible makes an important distinction between **5**. "belief that" and "belief in."
- Our faith goes deeper than knowing things about God! 6.
- In better understanding our faith, we need to remember that God's truth goes beyond reason but never against reason (2 Cor. 1:18; Titus 1:9 ESV).
- 8. God's truth can be a mystery.
- I can trust God for what I don't know because of what He's revealed to me that I do know.
- Christianity is a system of truth, with no error in major doctrines. All other 10. religions in the world are a system of error with occasional truths.

Scripture Commands Us to Defend the Faith





Being Ready

The Greek word for ready (Hetoimos) is used in Matt 24:44 and Luke 12:40 to communicate the idea that as Christians we need to anticipate Christ's return.

Now, if we combine 1 Peter 3:15 with 2 Corinthians 10:5 and I Cor. 9:22, it is clear that our responsibility as Christians is also to **eagerly** anticipate the questions and objections that our non-Christian friends may raise against Christianity, whether they ask us a **specific** question or not!




Branches of Philosophy


- 1. Metaphysics (The study of reality)






Truth Corresponds to Reality



Understanding God and Logic

- 1. The laws of logic are <u>fundamental</u> to all thought.
 - Logic makes rational thought possible.
 - Without logic there is no rational thought!

Logic is like a computer operating system that runs your computer programs. Without it you could not run any of your programs. Without logic, you could not function in life.

Without logic you could not understand any of the truth claims in scripture. Without logic you also could not rule out any statement as being contrary to scripture!
